



Travel Season is November through August

Club Fees Include:

Tryouts, Indoor training 2x per week, town-owned indoor field rental, staff payroll (coaching staff to assist, administration, building staffing and maintenance), GK training, outdoor field maintenance and equipment, coaching equipment and apparel, outdoor league fees (BWNYSL or Thruway League), referee costs for league play, Player registration with the state, player and coach insurance, coach registration fees, parent coaching incentives, scholarship costs, rent and utility/building fees (Village Glen lease), associated administrative and web site costs.

Estimated Team Expenses:

Optional indoor winter league, Tournaments (3), team related apparel items, coach hotel costs (if away from Buffalo for tournaments), social events, end of year party, 6 -AIM Tournament raffle tickets per player (if held), coaching fee for non-parent

## Amherst Soccer Association Tryout Process

### For returning ASA players:

- The coaches and staff have performed at least 3 evaluations on all players over the course of the season
- The tryout sessions are designed to give each player a chance to be seen against different competition
- Decisions are made by independent evaluators, the current and incoming coaches, and the Technical Director.
- Prior year attendance and attitude and overall commitment is considered as well as soccer ability
- Invitations to a roster, whether A or B, must be accepted within 3 days of the late July email and deposit made.
- As players accept or decline, qualified B team players will be asked if they want to move to A
- Please be prepared to check your email if on vacation and make your decision as ASA will not be waiting this year for late actions. Only verifying with the coach is not acceptable.

### For new players to ASA:

- It is important to attend both sessions to allow the coaches to assess your ability
- If there is information that the coaches should be aware of regarding your past play at other clubs, please see the Technical Director
- All placement offerings will be considered and invites will be emailed to all players around the end of July.
- You will have 3 days to accept and make a deposit or decline the invite to play before we move on to the next qualified player
- Please be prepared to check your email if on vacation and make your decision as ASA will not be waiting this year for late actions. Only verifying with the coach is not acceptable.

In all cases, placement decisions and options for dual card play, training only options, and team assignment are at the discretion of the coaches and leadership of ASA
